

An elevator services all floors and the reverse floor plan puts the great room and public rooms on the top level. The master suite opens to the rear garden and includes a walk-in closet and sumptuous spa bathroom.

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and ultra low-flow fixtures speak to water conservation. Twice the amount of roof insulation as typical demonstrates sincerity in

responsible energy consumption.

Three bedrooms — including the master suite — occupy the entry level. The master suite opens to the rear garden and includes a massive walk-in closet. An Ethos Luxury Modern soaking tub stands beside a two-person shower with dual shower heads in the superlative spa bathroom. Clara walnut cabinetry and modern vanities complete the striking oasis.

A spacious and richly appointed kitchen features a custom island and a suite of highend appliances. The mix of traditional and open cabinetry deftly blends modern and classical designs. A welcoming breakfast nook rests beside the kitchen, hosting a custom LED wood chandelier.

The home is designed to achieve LEED certification by the U.S. Green Building Council, meaning every system prioritizes efficiency and sustainability.

Automated controls and energy-efficient features exist throughout the home. Drought-tolerant plantings

Both the living and dining rooms on the

Both the living and dining rooms on the lower level open to a rear patio with Japanese maples and bamboo plantings. This guest level offers a private entrance off Dolores Street and includes bike storage, the garage and a laundry closet with high-efficiency hookups.

Parking is always a concern in San Francisco, especially in older homes. The PivotHouse's design solves this by simply boring into the bedrock to build a larger garage. Installing a Phantom Park car elevator allows residents to stash one vehicle 10 feet underground.

Vehicles aren't the only ones with elevator access. A residential elevator accesses all floors as well.

The main level overlooks Dolores Street, the city skyline and the bay. An Ortal fire-place warms the living room as motorized



Named for its eight-foot pivoting front door, the skillfully presented residence is known as the PivotHouse. The PivotHouse employs a reverse floor plan that sees its public rooms on higher levels and bedrooms on lower floors. This design ensures guests see the home in its best light.

Standing five stories tall, the home can live as either one single-family home or a home with a separate living unit on its lower level.

Stand at the built-in rotisserie grill on the roof deck and look left for an unbroken view at Sutro Tower. Succulents and droughttolerant flowers accent the sunny space that hosts both a dining area and a hot tub.

Another set of steps leads to the highest point of the home, where glass railings border an outdoor fireplace as the cityscape unfolds in the distance.

East-west orientation lets the front frame see sunrises as the back of the home enjoys
